



TLILIC4011A LICENCE TO OPERATE A SLEWING MOBILE CRANE (OVER 100 TONNES)

Duration:

Option 1 – 5 days involving training, supervision and assessment

Option 2 – 4 day training, logbook hours in the workplace, 1 day assessment

Who Should Attend?

Any person intending to or currently operating a Slewing Mobile Crane up to and over 100 tonnes in workplaces under the WH&S Legislation. Legislation requires the operator to hold a high risk work licence.

Expiry: 5 years

Slewing Mobile Cranes:

This licence encompasses authority for the operation of:

- Slewing mobile crane 20 tonnes or less – C2
- Slewing mobile crane 60 tonnes or less – C6
- Slewing mobile crane 100 tonnes or less – C1
- Non – slewing mobile crane – CN
- Vehicle loading crane – CV
