RIIWH202D ENTER AND WORK IN CONFINED SPACES

DURATION:	1 Day
VENUE:	To be negotiated: Onsite at clients premises or provided by Reserve (this will be dependant upon the physical resources available at client's workplace required for the practical assessment component)
DATE & TIME:	To be negotiated by the client and Reserve Training and Safety
STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:	Sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills to read, comprehend and follow instructions. A basic understanding of the English language is required.
REQUIRED RESOURCES:	All training resources to be provided by Reserve Training and Safety Physical resources (eg. suitably relevant 'confined spaces' and required PPE and safety equipment) supplied by the client's onsite or supplied by Reserve Training and Safety offsite
COURSE DELIVERY:	The theory training will be conducted in a classroom environment and will cover the following topics: <i>Definition, atmospheres, risk control, hazards, PPE, work to be performed, communication, atmospheric testing, equipment and safeguard, respiratory protection types, permit system, cleaning, purging and ventilation, emergency and work completion.</i>
ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS:	There will be two (2) practical assessment components for each student to meet unit competency requirements. These will consist of atmospheric testing, permit completion and rescue plan awareness.
AT COURSE COMPLETION:	Student will receive a Nationally Recognised 'Statement of Attainment' issued by Reserve Training and Safety. There is no expiry date on this however future refresher courses may be required if requested by your Employer. In the event of a SOA reprint from Reserve Training and Safety a fee of \$25 will apply.
COST / PAYMENT:	To be negotiated based on venue and student numbers
